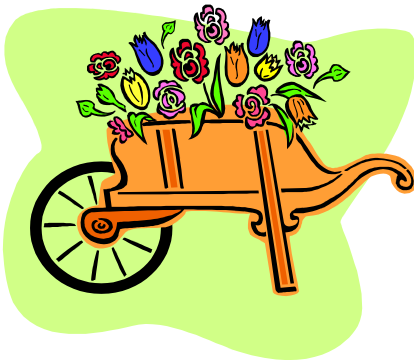
Speaker Bio: Jim Sleezer, CISA
