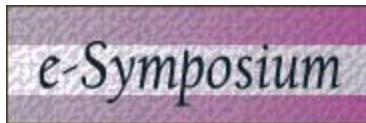

June 2009 Exam Results

Exam results for the June 2009 exam were released in early August via e-mail and postal mail. To ensure the confidentiality of scores, exam results will not be reported by telephone or fax. Candidates who elected to receive email notification (i.e., consented to item #25 on the registration form) should have received a one-time result notification via e-mail in early August. To ensure receipt of these documents, candidates should update their profiles if any contact information has changed and add exam@isaca.org to their address book or safe-senders list. Candidates will also be able to view their exam scores at www.isaca.org using their login credentials and password.

CGEIT Exam and Study Materials

ISACA is developing a Certified in the Governance of Enterprise IT® (CGEIT®) review manual to assist candidates in preparing for the CGEIT exam. The *CGEIT® Review Manual* is scheduled to be completed in late 2009.

For the 12 December 2009 CISA, CISM and CGEIT certification the final registration deadline is 23 September 2009.
