Are you taking advantage of your ISACA membership to access essential information to support your audit and/or IT responsibilities? As many of you know, the IT Governance Institute (ITGI) is ISACA's research affiliate conducting original research in the field of IT governance.

ITGI publishes guidelines and best practices to assist corporate management at all levels govern their information technology resources. ITGI first published COBIT version 1.0 in 1994 to help companies align their information technology investment with business objectives. Later this November, ITGI will be releasing COBIT 4.0.

In addition, later this year, ITGI will also release a set of publications designed to help companies create greater value from their information technology investment. This new set of publications will be known as "Val IT". Val IT will focus upon the IT investment decision and the realization of benefits as opposed to COBIT which focuses upon IT process execution and control. Val IT has a great potential to help corporate managers measure, monitor and maximize corporate investment in information technologies.

Members of the Central Oklahoma ISACA Chapter have access to ITGI's research; which are, for the most part, offered as free downloads from the ITGI web site, www.itgi.org. Some items are purchase-only; and are offered through the ISACA Bookstore, www.isaca.org/bookstore.
